

# Bourrée in E Minor

Lute or Lute-Harpischord (Lautenwerk)

J. S. Bach

Measures 1-4 of the Bourrée in E Minor. The piece is in E minor (one sharp, F#) and 3/4 time. The melody in the treble clef consists of eighth and sixteenth notes, while the bass clef provides a steady accompaniment of quarter notes.

Measures 5-8 of the Bourrée in E Minor. Measure 8 features a repeat sign, indicating the beginning of a first ending.

Measures 9-14 of the Bourrée in E Minor. The melody continues with eighth and sixteenth notes, and the bass line remains consistent with quarter notes.

Measures 15-19 of the Bourrée in E Minor. Measure 15 includes a fermata over the first note. The piece concludes with a repeat sign in measure 19.

Measures 20-24 of the Bourrée in E Minor. The final section of the piece, ending with a repeat sign in measure 24.
